- 6. SCHEDULED BUSINESS
 - A. DICK WELCH TOWNSHIP RESIDENT AND A REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE CAMBRIDGE

 AREA PICKLEBALL ASSOCIATION PLAYERS. DICK CAME BEFORE THE BOARD TO ENLIGHTEN THEM ON THE LOCAL GROWING INTEREST AND THE ADVANTAGES OF EXERCISE FOR SENIORS AND OTHERS THAT ARE PARTAKING IN PICKLEBALL. THE PICKLEBALL COMMITTEE AND THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE ARE NEGOTIATING AN AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH A NUMBER OF OUTSIDE PICKLEBALL COURTS.  - A. ROB'S REPORT

- i) 2019 MINNESOTA FALL MAINTENANCE EXPO ROB, JIM AND PETE ATTENDED THE EXPO. THEY ATTENDED THE CULVERT LECTURE CLASS. JIM HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO TALK TO A REPRESENTATIVE OF A COMPANY THAT HAS A PRODUCT USING BEET JUICE FOR DEICING TREATMENTS ON ROADS. THE REPRESENTATIVE HAS AGREED TO COME TO THE TOWNSHIP GARAGE AND GIVE A TALK ON THE PRODUCT.
- ii) **DUST CONTROL** THE BRIDGE IS CLOSED IN STANCHFIELD TOWNSHIP ON 373RD AVE NE. AS A RESULT, TRAFFIC IS USING 373RD AVE TO THE EAST AND THEN SOUTH ONTO ZEST ST TO GAIN ACCESS TO CO. ROAD 6. THE TRAFFIC NUMBER IS QUITE HIGH AND THE ROAD IS TOO HARD TO KEEP REASONABLY PASSABLE. ROB HAD 15 LOADS OF GRAVEL SPREAD ON THE TWO ROADS IN CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP AND HASS CONSTRUCTION ARRANGED TO HAVE DUST CONTROL (CALCIUM CHLORIDE) SPREAD ON THE ROAD.
- iii) **357TH AVE (WEST OF HASTINGS ST.)** TO BUILD UP THE ROAD IN ONE AREA, ROB HAD 51 LOADS OF FILL AND 5 BELLY DUMPS OF GRAVEL SPREAD ON THE ROAD.
- iv) **GRANDY PINES AREA** AS A RESULT OF ALL THE RAIN, THE WET GROUND AND THE HIGH WINDS HAVE CAUSED A NUMBER OF TREES TO FALL ALONG THE ROAD. THE TOWNSHIP HAS WORKED WITH FISH LAKE TOWNSHIP USING THEIR CHIPPER HERE AND ALSO ALONG 357TH AVE.
- v) **337TH AVE NE** ROB IS WATCHING THAT PART OF THE ROAD THAT GOES THRU BLOMGREN LAKE. THE WATER IS GETTING QUITE HIGH AND THE TOWNSHIP MAY HAVE TO CLOSE THAT PORTION OF 337TH AVE. NE.
- vi) **CULVERT INSTALLATIONS:** THE TOWNSHIP HAS INSTALLED CULVERTS IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS: 1. 357TH AVE NE (WEST OF HASTINGS ST) 2. 357TH AVE NE (EAST OF CO. RD 14)
- vii) **MEADWOOD IV (NASTROM PLAT)** A CULVERT HAS BEEN INSTALLED ACROSS THE DRIVEWAY ROAD TO RELIEVE THE PRESSURE OF DITCH WATER ON THE ROAD BY ALLOWING A PATH OF WATER MOVEMENT TO THE SWAMP AREA.

 INVESTIGATED THE INCIDENT, THEY FOUND THAT THE TOWNSHIP WAS NOT
 NEGLIGENT.

TO HAVE THE CULVERT ON THEIR PRIVATE DRIVEWAY REPLACED. THE CULVERT
IS ESSENTIAL TO KEEPING THE WATER MOVING AND NOT OVER-FLOWING ONTO
THE TOWNSHIP ROAD. THE RESIDENT HAS AGREED TO HAVE THE CULVERT
REPLACED AND THE EXPENSE ASSESSED TO THEIR PROPERTY TAX. THE
TOWNSHIP BOARD HAS AGREED ON THE TERMS OF INTEREST = 2% AND THE
TERM OF REPAYMENT TO BE 10 YEARS. THE CLERK WILL WRITE UP AN
AGREEMENT FOR THE COST OF THE CULVERT/INSTALLATION REIMBURSEMENT
FROM THE PROPERTY OWNERS TO THE TOWNSHIP. JIM AND ROB WILL THEN
DELIVER THE AGREEMENT TO THE PROPERTY OWNERS FOR SIGNATURE.
