CAMBRIDGE TOWNSHIP RIGHT-OF-WAY ORDINANCE

On June 8, 2026, the Town Board adopted the Cambridge Township Right-of-Way Ordinance to protect the Town's road rights-of-ways, ensure safe travel, and prevent damage or interference with roads, drainage systems, and public infrastructure. The ordinance establishes regulations governing obstructions, approaches, culverts, drainage, parking, towing, and the use of rights-of-way by utilities. It requires permits for work in the right-of-way, sets standards for restoration, authorizes enforcement actions and penalties, and outlines procedures for establishing and maintaining new Town roads.
